Commission Youth Sports Programs

Code of Conduct Covers:

- Nashville Parks and Recreation Commission (NPRC) expects all persons entering a park facility during an organized youth sporting activity to demonstrate behavior that aligns with the highest of standard of sportsmanship and fair play.
- The code of conduct is in addition to all existing rules of NPRC. The commission or employees of NPRC reserve the right to take disciplinary action against any individual whose actions or behavior has been deemed detrimental to NPRC. This includes but is not limited to suspensions and/or expulsion.

Specific Actions Deemed Detrimental to Nashville Parks and Recreation Commission Youth Sports Programs:

- Physical Attack: against an umpire, referee, coach, league administrator, parent, or player during or following a game.
- Threat of Violence: against an umpire, referee, coach, league administrator, parent, or player that goes beyond the confines of the park facilities and is related to events during or following a game.
- Actual or Threat of Violence: with any person during or following a game.

Guidelines for Suspension or Expulsion (Actions Deemed Detrimental)

- First Offense: Minimum 4 Games up to 1 Calendar Year Suspension.
- Second Offense: Minimum 1 Calendar Year Suspension up to Expulsion from the League.
- Third Offense: Expulsion from League.
- In addition, there will be no profanity, obscene gestures, alcohol, weapons, or drugs permitted anywhere in the park area. Smoking or use of tobacco products is limited to the areas designated by smoking receptacles. These offences will result in immediate ejection of the individual and notification of the proper authorities.
- The commission and/or employees of Nashville Parks and Recreation Commission will be required to investigate all allegations that violate the code of conduct. Individuals may be required to appear before Nashville Parks and Recreation Commission staff or have their written statements collected for review. All actions taken by Nashville Parks and Recreation Commission as it relates to conduct issues are subject to an appeal, if information is available that was not available at the time of the initial review.
